For my part, I've tried to help you plan your trip, and I've given you a list of possible accommodations with prices and contacts. But I can't possibly take care of the logistical aspects of your reservations or any other payments. Similarly, although it's not part of my remit, I've tried to make your journey easier by establishing contacts through my own network to speed things up. As I said, the local authorities and associations are ready to meet you and appreciate your investment. I think your letter through the consulate in Rotterdam could be an excellent way of formalizing your project.

As far as the list of participants is concerned, you're free to do as you please. As I said before, I'm happy to accompany you on a personal basis. By the way, if you're already accompanied by another teacher, I think that should suffice. I could continue to accompany you by being in constant contact with the contacts established on site, without needing to be with you in the field?

One last point concerns your gifts: I've been waiting to hear from my bookseller. After explaining your project to her, she also confirmed that the packed lunch option should be avoided. She also advised me to think about small packages (hats, warm clothes, socks), which she felt would be timeless and extremely useful. She also told me about games and small toys. For school supplies, she reminded me that the administration already distributes binders with school supplies at the start of each school year. I contacted my bookseller to try and negotiate discounts or advantages for you, and she made it clear that in your case, it would be preferable to go to the superstores or the big booksellers, as the price would be similar in this case.
