Thank you for submitting and sending your thesis. Upon review, and after the check with a mandatory plagiarism tool, we have noticed however that portions of text in your thesis closely mirrors the wording in sources you have relied upon. As such, these sections should be enclosed in quotation marks. Large portions of text from other sources should not, in principle, be used word-for-word.

As you know, all information in your thesis must be properly referenced. This entails not only citing your sources in footnotes, which you have done, but also either placing direct quotes in quotation marks or rephrasing the content in your own words. When paraphrasing, however, you must ensure that the text is substantially different from the original source. Merely removing a few words or changing words to synonyms is insufficient.

Unfortunately, and despite directions from your supervisor over time, your thesis does not comply with these guidelines. While progress has been made over previous submissions, significant problem areas remain.
